## Brisbane Catholic Education & School

### Device Management

BCE devices are configured with firewalls, filters, and monitoring tools

### Filtered Internet Access

Inappropriate websites blocked across BCE networks

### Acceptable Use Agreements

Students and parents sign ICT use policies each year

### IT Support

BCE schools have IT staff or services available to assist with tech issues



## Parents / Guardians

### Awareness of Student Acceptable Use Agreement

Familiarise yourself with the student technology agreement

### Parental Controls

Use parental controls on home Wi-Fi or apps like Family Zone or Google Family Link

### Home Supervision

Ensure device use happens in shared family spaces

### Monitor Activity

Regularly check browser history and discuss online behaviour



## Students

### Use BCE Wi-Fi

Where the network is filtered

### Think Critically Online

Not all information is trustworthy

### Ask For Help

If you see anything upsetting or feel unsafe online

### Don't Share Passwords

Or personal information with others

### Log Out and Shut Down

When done—protect privacy and battery life
